

Parallels Mac Management v4.0: Pre-Installation Checklist

For successful installation of the Parallels Mac Management® plug-in for Microsoft® System Center Configuration Manager (SCCM), you must complete the checklist below. If all items are not reviewed, end clients will not be able to install Parallels Mac Management properly. To receive installation support from Parallels, you should complete this checklist and return it to your account executive.

- Check the General requirements for supported SCCM, Windows and OS X versions – p. 10
- Proxy requirement – .NET Framework 4.0 is required – p. 10
